

“Stained Glass” Prayer Windows

Materials:

Black construction paper for frames- 2 per student

Cut up pieces of multi-colored tissue paper

Typed prayers- 1 per student

Wax paper- 2 sheets per student

Hole punch

Yarn- 12” per student

Iron

Cloth towel

Staple

Glue sticks

Scissors

Have students trace and cut out frames (gothic window or heart shape works well). Students sprinkle tissue paper pieces in a thin (single) layer on one piece of wax paper. Next place the prayer in the center, then cover with another piece of wax paper, sandwich style. Cover both pieces with a towel or paper book cover and carefully iron, melting the wax and sealing the tissue paper and prayer in between the two layers. Glue and staple the frames together on either side of the melted wax paper , being careful to match them up, and center them over the prayer. Trim off excess wax paper. Punch a hole in the top and tie on yarn hanger.
